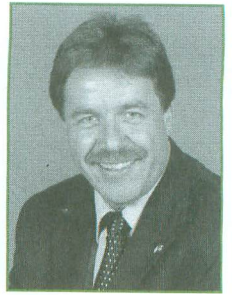

Thank you for your e-mail dated April 7, 2009. I have introduced several Private Members Bills in the House of Commons concerning water in Canada:

Bill C-219, 40 Parliament, 2nd Session
An act to amend the Fisheries Act (deposit in lakes) First Reading
SUMMARY
This enactment prohibits the use of lakes for depositing deleterious substances.

Bill C-250, 39th Parliament, 2nd Session
An act to ensure safe drinking water throughout Canada
SUMMARY
This enactment provides for the establishment of national standards for safe drinking water in Canada and for the reporting of non-compliance with those standards.
